Bluebird House w/Cedar Picket

Instructions

- 1. Cut the cedar picket as shown. We suggest you measure and cut one piece at a time. On the bottom, cut the corners off for ventilation. The top of the back and front and both ends of the top should be cut with a 20 degree angle.
- Drill a hole that is 1 1/2" in diameter and the center is 2" from the top.
- 3. Nail back, one side, front , bottom and top in place
- 4. Watch the video for directions to hinge the 2nd side.

- 5. You can also use a simple gate latch or anything that will keep the side door closed. A screw will work but is more trouble to remove for cleaning.

The wood needed is a 6 foot cedar fence picket

You can also use a 1 X 6 X 6 board. If you use a 1 X 6 board, the measurements will vary some.

Don't use treated wood.

0	Front 10"
	Top 9"
	Side 1 11 3/4" on one side 9 3/4" on the other
	Side 2 Same as side 1
