

Bluebird House Post Mount

Instructions

1. Cut the cedar picket as shown. We suggest you measure and cut one piece at a time. On the bottom, cut the corners off for ventilation. The top of the back and front and both ends of the top should be cut with a 20 degree angle.
2. Drill a hole that is 1 1/2" in diameter and the center is 2" from the top.
3. Nail back, one side, front, bottom and top in place
4. Watch the video for directions to hinge the 2nd side.

5. You can also use a simple gate latch or anything that will keep the side door closed. A screw will work but is more trouble to remove for cleaning.
6. Install and enjoy

You can also use a 1 X 6 X 6 board. If you use a 1 X 6 board, the measurements will vary some.

Don't use treated wood.
