## No Drill Bluebird House

## Instructions

- Cut the 1" x 6" board as shown. We suggest you measure and cut one piece at a time. On the bottom, cut the corners off for ventilation.
- The top of the back and both ends of the top should be cut with a 10 degree angle.
- Cut shallow grooves on the inside of the front panel from about 1/2 way up.
- Nail back, one side, front, bottom and top in place. Ensure the slot opening is 1 & 3/16" opening.
- Watch the video for directions to hinge the 2nd side.

- 6. You can also use a simple gate latch or anything that will keep the side door closed. A screw will work but is more trouble to remove for cleaning.
- 7. Install and enjoy
